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# RAMESH TERDAL

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The artist Ramesh Terdal, born in 1972 in India, managed to sculpt his name in the field of Visual Art. Abroad he has reached a great recognition in the Visual Art receiving twice the "Karnataka Lalit kala Academy Awards" and ten times the "National level Awards." Moreover, he has been invited by the governments Slovenian and Austrian to show his art, and to teach it to their citizens. In the last twenty years of his career, he has participated in workshop, in India and abroad (New Delhi, Bangalore, Kolakatta, Pondicherry, Slovenia, Hungary, Austria etc.), he has exhibited his works all over the world: Austria, Slovenia, Italy, England, Texas, Florida, Paris, New Delhi, Mumbai, etc.

In 2018, Terdal was hypnotized by the giant aquarium in Dubai and the creatures that animated it had the idea of creating the series, *Expression*. Definable but indefinable images, colors and an infinite, hidden behind every brushstroke of the works of Ramesh Terdal, a child born with art and with it became a man. His works take shape from the ability to express himself through art, one of the most sublime ways that man can dispose of.

The artist, in this series of works, was inspired by aesthetics of Benedict Croce: *the art is previously a synthesis of the aesthetics, synthesis of feeling and image in the intuition: the feeling without the image is blind, and the image without the feeling is empty*. According to Benedict Croce: *the art represents the feeling, and only from it and above of it can rise [...] the art is intuition lyric (ndr) feeling everything convert in images welcoming the pure one to palpitate some life in its ideality*. Intuition and expression are: *a non-expressive image, that is a word, song, drawing is a non-existent thing*.

The exposed works evolve from the intuitive expression of the psyche: *when I paint, I try to reproduce my sense of imagination, my experience, my feelings in the form of different brushstrokes, shapes and textures.* Abstract forms of aquatic animals, birds and human figures are the subjects that travel from a surreal world passed through the oniriches waters of the ocean. The use of bright and bright colors mirrors the vivacious soul of the composition which results to be inversely proportional to the drama of the feeling that they generate.

In these works he has adopted a strong and engaging visual language through which he expresses his beliefs, emotions and nuances. An almost magical reality emerges, suspended in time and space. In front of his works we perceive the dialogue between the soul of the author and the matter of his work. The brush strokes are powerful and energetic. Terdal performs his works with automatic procedures, unconditional and instinctive gestures, letting himself be guided by the spontaneity and his emotions that generate these works.

Doing what you love and being successful is only possible when the feelings you are trying to convey also reach the soul of others.

L'artista Ramesh Terdal, nato nel 1972 in India, è riuscito a scolpire in suo nome nel campo della Visual Art. All'estero ha ricevuto due volte il "Karnataka Lalit kala Acedemy State Awards" e dieci volte il "National level Awards". Inoltre, è stato invitato dai governi sloveno e austriaco a mostrare la sua arte e insegnarla ai loro cittadini. Negli ultimi vent'anni della sua carriera, ha partecipato a workshop, in India e all'estero (New Delhi, Bangalore, Kolakatta, Pondicherry, Slovenia, Ungheria, Austria ecc.), ed ha esposto i suoi lavori in tutto in mondo: Austria, Slovenia, Italia, Inghilterra, Texas, Florida, Parigi, Nuova Delhi, Mumbai, ecc.

Nel 2018 Terdal mentre era ipnotizzato dal gigante acquario di Dubai e dalle creature che lo animavano ebbe l'idea di realizzare la serie, *Expression*. Immagini definibili ma indefinibili, colori e un infinito, nascosto dietro ogni pennellata delle opere di Ramesh Terdal, un bambino nato con l'arte e con essa diventato uomo. Le sue opere prendono forma dalla capacità di esprimere sé stesso attraverso l'arte, uno dei modi più sublimi di cui l'uomo può disporre.

L'artista, nella serie *Expression*, si è ispirato all'estetica crociana: *l'arte è una sintesi a priori dell'estetica, sintesi di sentimento ed immagine nell'intuizione: il sentimento senza l'immagine è cieco, e l'immagine senza il sentimento è vuota*. Secondo Benedetto Croce: *l'arte rappresenta il sentimento, e solo da esso e sopra di esso può sorgere [...] l'arte è intuizione lirica (ndr) sentimento tutto convertito in immagini accogliendo il puro palpitaro della vita nella sua idealità*. Intuizione ed espressione sono: *un'immagine non espressiva, che sia una parola, canto, disegno è una cosa inesistente*.

*La serie Expression evolve dall'espressione intuitiva della psiche: quando dipingo, cerco di riprodurre il mio senso dell'immaginazione, la mia esperienza, i miei sentimenti sotto forma di diverse pennellate, forme e trame. Forme apparentemente astratte di animali acquatici, uccelli e figure umane sono i soggetti che viaggiano da un mondo surreale passato attraverso le oniriche acque dell'oceano. L'uso di colori brillanti e luminosi rispecchia l'anima vivace della composizione la quale risulta essere inversamente proporzionale alla drammaticità del sentimento che generano.*

*In queste opere ha adottato un linguaggio visivo forte e coinvolgente attraverso il quale esprimere le sue credenze, emozioni e sfumature. Emerge una realtà quasi magica, sospesa nel tempo e nello spazio. Di fronte alle sue opere si percepisce il dialogo tra l'anima dell'autore e la materia della sua opera. Le pennellate sono potenti ed energiche. Tendal compie le opere con procedimenti automatici, gesti incondizionati e istintivi, lasciandosi guidare dalla spontaneità e dalle sue emozioni che generano questi lavori.*

*Fare ciò che si ama e riuscire ad ottenere successo è possibile solo nel momento in cui i sentimenti che si cerca di trasmettere arrivano anche all'anima degli altri.*






